Rules and Regulations

Pool Hours	June 17-25 and August 19 – September 4: 11:00 AM – 7:00 PM June 26 – August 18: Weekdays 3:45 PM - 8:30 PM; Weekends 11:00 AM – 8:00 PM
Tennis Courts	The two tennis courts are open the same hours as the pool. Private group lessons are taught weekdays Monday through Thursday and instructors have priority of use until 6:00 PM Monday - Friday (occasional Friday's are used for rained out lessons) June 26 to August 18. A party may not occupy a court longer than 30 minutes once another party indicates a desire to use the courts. The lifeguard should be notified and is responsible for clearing the court for the oncoming party when the 30 minutes has expired.
Play Areas	Swim Club parents must supervise their own children when using outdoor activity areas, even when there are Meadow Breeze Staff on duty watching campers. Footwear must be worn when outside the pool fence.
Parking	Parking is limited to the macadam parking lot only. No parking is allowed off the pavement.
Fees	<p>Full Membership Fees: \$200 for the first family member, \$190 for a second member of the same family and \$120 for each additional family member under age 21. A membership for children under age 18 requires adult supervision (see health & safety rules 9, 10). You may pay by: Visa, MasterCard, Electronic Check, or regular Checks. All regular checks should be made payable to Meadow Breeze Swim & Tennis Club. A \$50 Deposit is due at the time of Registration. The remaining balance is due June 1, 2017. There is a \$50 fee for any cancelations. Fees are neither refundable nor transferable. There is no charge for a child born after July 1, 2015 (all diapers are forbidden in the pool). There is no charge for a "sitter" that does not enter the pool.</p> <p>Limited Membership Fees: \$125 for the first family member, \$120 for a second member of the same family, and \$80 for each additional family member under age 21. Pool use times are limited to 7:00PM – 8:30 PM on weekdays between June 26 and August 18. All other dates the pool is available opening time to closing time.</p> <p>Guest Fees: Daily fees are \$5 per guest. No more than 4 guests per member family will be allowed on any one day without previous permission being granted from the Camp Director or from the Swim Club Director, unless the guests are all members of the same family. Upon their arrival, a member must bring guests to the Head Lifeguard. Guest fees will be collected at that time by the lifeguard. Failure to report a guest can result in the loss of guest privileges and will incur an administrative fee.</p> <p>Weekday Guest Passes: These are available at a discounted rate of \$50 for fifteen passes for the 2017 Swim Club season. These guest cards are not transferable, and cannot be used for weekend or holiday visitors. They are usable for the 2017 season only.</p>
Gas Grill	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The gas grills are for use by members, guests, and the lifeguards. Please shut off following use. The use of the grills is under the jurisdiction of the lifeguards. • Please clean grill surface following use.
Health & Safety	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All swimmers must immediately leave the pool area in the event of an electrical storm. 2. No glass containers may be brought onto the pool deck. 3. No pets are allowed inside the fenced area. 4. Only lifeguards are allowed inside the pump house. 5. No one who is intoxicated will be permitted to enter or remain in the pool area.

6. No one who is intoxicated will be permitted to enter or remain in the pool area.
7. No “dunking,” running, pushing, wrestling, or “horse play” is permitted in the pool or pool area.
8. No bicycles or skateboards are allowed inside the fenced area, including the tennis courts.
9. Only swimmers who have passed the swimming test administered by the lifeguards are allowed to go past the depth where their feet can touch the bottom.
10. Children under the age of fourteen will be permitted to enter or remain in the pool area only when accompanied by a parent or responsible “sitter” that is inside the fence for the pool area. There is no charge for sitters that do not enter the pool.
11. Fun noodles, kick boards, or any floatation devices are used by permission of the head lifeguard only.
12. No chewing gum is allowed in the water.
13. No one with a skin infection or communicable illness will be permitted to use the pool.
14. Children who are not toilet trained are forbidden in any part of the main pool, including the stairs, at all times.
15. Smoking is not permitted inside the fenced area.
16. Trash should be placed in the containers provided inside the pool area.
17. Use of inside rooms is limited to access to bathrooms and locker rooms for showering and changing. Classrooms and play areas in the building are off limits to Swim Club members.
18. Failure to abide by the rules and regulations shall be brought to the attention of the Director and may be cause for suspension of member privileges for such a period as the Director shall see fit. Any suspensions during the summer will require the member to attend a meeting with the Director and two lifeguards. This meeting is a requirement before pool membership status can be reinstated.

General

1. All persons who enter the pool area do so at their own risk. Lexington Christian Academy will not assume responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with pool use or for damage or loss of property.
2. Damage to pool property caused by a pool member or the guest of a member will be charged to the responsible member unless caused by normal wear and tear.
3. There will be no private pool parties allowed during high volume weekends and holidays. Members that want to invite more than 4 non-members as guests for a party at the pool must get permission from the Camp Director or Swim Club Director in advance.
4. Both private and group instruction classes are available to members at an additional cost.
5. Members must report to Life Guards upon arrival and identify all members and guests that are visiting the pool.
6. All previous members are given priority for membership. After March 13, membership priority is on a “first come, first served” basis.

Lifeguards

1. Lifeguards will be on duty for all hours of operation; however, on bad weather days at the lifeguard’s discretion, the pool will be closed.
2. Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing the rules and regulations and to preserve and protect pool property.
3. Lifeguards may close the pool or the pool area for reasons of health and safety. They may also clear the pool for brief intervals at their discretion.
4. Lifeguards may require any person to leave the pool area and surrounding property if, in the opinion of the lifeguard, such person is endangering the health, safety, or pleasure of others, or if there is refusal to conform to the rules and regulations. All such instances shall be reported to the Director and a meeting must take place before reinstatement can occur.
